IMPORTANT TELEHEALTH UPDATE FOR HDHP MEMBERS

In 2020, the federal government provided temporary relief during COVID that allowed telemedicine to be covered without affecting other health coverage when used with a high deductible health plan (HDHP). This meant that people could keep contributing to their health savings accounts (HSAs) while employers offered telemedicine services without requiring HDHP members to meet their deductible first.

Unfortunately, Congress did not extend this COVID relief before they adjourned in December 2024. This means that starting January 1, 2025, using general telemedicine or telehealth services will make you ineligible to contribute to your HSA if you have an HDHP. To assist all Light & Wonder Creators and Sci-Players enrolled in the Aetna HDHP plan in continuing their HSA contributions in 2025, we have implemented some changes to the telehealth services.

Starting January 1, 2025, telehealth services through <u>Doctor on Demand</u> will have a \$45 copay for each visit. This change allows you to continue using telehealth services without having to meet your HDHP deductible first or losing your eligibility to contribute to your HSA.
